"IT BEGAN WITH ANGELS!" A group of knitters at Burley in Wharfedale Methodist Church decided to copy an idea from Cullercoats Methodist Church in the North-East and knit tiny angels which would be given out around the village last Christmas.

Approximately 320 angels were made, and were given out, with a Christmas greeting, to the various groups that use our church, the village shops and early morning commuters catching the train to Leeds.

In January, the knitters turned their hands to making warm hats and scarves for those in Calais in "the Jungle" refugee camp. by the end of February over 200 hats and around 60 scarves had been sent out to Calais, Dunkirk, and more recently to the Macedonian border.

The group grew bigger and the Wharfedale Refugee Response Group became involved, and a number of packed cars have taken clothes (included knitted hats and bootees!), nappies, medicine and food to be packed into a container destined for Syria at the end of March.

More projects are in the pipeline to try to relieve the terrible suffering of the refugees around Europe and the Middle East. If you'd like any more information on how you can get involved, please contact Chris Price on 01943 864445.
