The Church will be working together with WYDAN- The West Yorkshire Destitute Asylum Network, a charity based in Leeds to provide a week's night shelter for asylum seekers.

WYDAN is a network of organisations and individuals in West Yorkshire, committed to supporting destitute asylum seekers who have no recourse to public funds.

To find out more about this charity please look at their website www.wydan.org where you can read of all the work that they do and the services they provide.

Each year the organisation looks for hosts for their winter night shelters. As a Church we will be working with the other Churches and different organisations in the area to provide a week's shelter for ten men.

The charity provides the basic 'shelter' of beds and bedding and as hosts we will be required to provide hospitality, meals and travel passes as well as a warm welcome.

Please pray for this project as we step out in faith together.

An opportunity to acknowledge and remember a lost baby in a safe and supportive environment. Open to anyone of any faith or none.


