

Timble Chapel Management Group

Remit

Objectives:

1. To enable the Chapel to remain open and to host services at Christmas, Easter, Church Anniversary and Harvest.
2. To enable the Chapel to remain open throughout the day as a sacred space for walkers cyclists and visitors to the village.

The Management Group

The group to consist of members of the Wharfedale and Aireborough Methodist Circuit and residents of the village and to be chaired by the Superintendent of the Wharfedale and Aireborough Methodist Circuit.

The group to meet at least once a quarter with the option of more meetings in the initial phases of the project.

The group to be responsible for the day to day management of the building on behalf of the Wharfedale and Aireborough Methodist Circuit, who will act as the managing trustees. The Management Group will report twice a year to the Circuit Meeting.

Financial Management

Monies held in the Timble Chapel bank account to be transferred to the Wharfedale and Aireborough Methodist Circuit account. Timble monies to be ring fenced within the Circuit account and to be shown in a separate column on the Circuit accounts.

Geoff Boldero to hold a cash float of £100 for minor expenses.

Building Management

1. The building will continue to be insured by Methodist Insurance.
2. The Management Group will be responsible for ensuring that Schedule A is completed annually.
3. Members of the Management Group living in the village to keep a regular check on the building, especially during spells of bad weather.
