CERTIFICATE IN WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP

Hosted by Cliff College Senior Tutor Ian White, the course is led by Dr. Joanna Williamson, co-founder of One Rock International and founder of SheLives, with contributions from the Cliff College Faculty, and other expert adjuncts. There is time for personal reflection and social space, as well as teaching delivered via lectures, seminars and workshops with practical as well as theoretical applications.

Aiming at developing the skills and confidence of women towards lay leadership roles, and supporting those already in lay leadership, the course focusses on the ministry of women both in a church setting, and also the wider marketplace of the community and business worlds.
