CHILDREN'S WORKER

We are seeking to appoint a part-time Children's Worker to support and develop new and existing activities for children, as part of a ministry team serving the Methodist churches in Bramhope, Guiseley and Yeadon.

We are looking for someone who enjoys working with children (primary age and younger), working with others and sometimes taking the lead.

This is a new post and the person appointed will be required to:

- Help lead toddler groups and activity groups for children.
- Build relationships with parents/carers and volunteer helpers.
- Help lead activities for local primary schools.

The appointment is initially for a fixed term of three years, which may be extended subject to review and future funding being available.

A satisfactory enhanced disclosure with barred lists check from the Disclosure and Barring Service will be required.

NEXT STEPS & MAIN TERMS

Hours of work: 15 hours per week, worked flexibly by mutual agreement with the

Line Manager, usually on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays, which may include some evening working. Flexibility in working days may be required from time to time to meet the requirements of the post. You will not be expected to work on more than three

days per calendar week.

Contract: Initial three years' fixed term contract.

Salary: £10,740.60 per annum for 15 hours per week (£13.77 per hour,

reviewed annually) with enrolment in the Circuit's workplace

pension scheme.

Location: Home based (although an office will be available in one of the

churches if preferred) and working in venues in Bramhope,

Guiselev and Yeadon.
